## ÜL CABERNET FRANC RESERVE

For the native people, ÜL denoted the songs and poetry that invoke the caring and value of Nature, songs that guard the Being that protects the Water.

This wine represents a constant search, the obsession that shows us what path to follow each year, to search for the precise impact of the climate, the expression of the land, the exact moment for the harvest...

VARIETY: 100 % CABERNET FRANC

### WINEYARD:

The grapes of this wine come from the vineyards especially selected in Vista Flores, in the Uco Valley at an average altitude of 1.100 mts. above sea level.

They are cultivated under a high density plantation and with a controlled performance of 7 tns/ha.

The grapes are harvested on the first week of April, to highlight the maximum varietal character and to obtain the maximum expression of the terroir.

They are hand picked in small plastic cases, with manual selection of the grapes in the vineyard.

### PRODUCTION:

Once the grapes arrive to the winery from each plot, they are manually selected.

Each batch from the different plots are produced separately in small stainless steel tanks. A cold pre-maceration fermentation is made to concentrate the color from the skins and promote the extraction of varietal aromas that highlight its authenticity.

The fermentation is made with natural yeasts, between 27 y 29°C (80 and 84°F).

Later, a small post-fermentation maceration is made to extract the polyphenols responsible of the structure and ageing potential of this great wine.

Ageing is made in French oak barrels for 12 months.

### TASTING NOTES:

ÜL CABERNET FRANC is a wine of great elegance and personality. The expression of the terroir and the ageing in the French oak barrels make it a wine of deep aromatic complexity, that highlights the balance between the fruit and the oak. When tasted, it stands out for its subtlety and unctuous sophistication, with a well-balanced and persistent finish.
